## Getting into the Databases

- 1) Your first trip to the Digital Pipeline may take a little extra effort. Your browser needs to be set to 'accept cookies' and the system will check your computer for Alaska origin.
- 2) If you live in Alaska and cannot access the databases, call 800.440.2919 for a recorded message about the databases, IDs and passwords. If you leave a message, someone will contact you.
- 3) Call your local library. If they cannot solve your problem, they will find someone who can.

## User ID and Passwords

If your Internet provider is not based in Alaska, you may be asked for an ID and password.

The Digital Pipeline does not allow ID/passwords to be sent in emails, shared on listservs or displayed on webpages. IP addresses of visiting computers are tracked to ensure these databases are used only by Alaskans. **Please do not share access codes outside of Alaska.**

Alaska libraries have contracted with several companies to provide Alaskans with Internet sources for:

- articles from magazines, journals and newspapers
- auto repair manuals
- genealogical research
- radio/TV transcripts
- online encyclopedias
- test preparation materials
- homework help online

Remember to ask at your local library if you have any questions. They will get you answers!
